**All students are required to take semester examinations at the scheduled times.** If a student misses the scheduled time for any unexcused reason (which would need to be rescheduled at the teacher's convenience), he or she will forfeit the opportunity to take the exam. Note: There will be no Matins or Lyceum during exam days, nor will there be homework assigned or due. **Seniors do not have an exam on Thursday and therefore do not need to come to school.**

Semester exams are cumulative across the semester and worth 20% of a student's semester grade. Grades will be posted on Chalkable no later than Tuesday, June 6. **Students should not contact their teachers for their results prior to then.** Students will be able to review their finals at the school after June 6.

All students should be on time for each exam, bringing other work to do if/when they finish, as **they will not be allowed to enter or leave the room once an exam has begun.** Students may bring with them bottles of water into the classroom, but no food will be permitted.

All students may leave campus for the Great Hall/lunch period if they desire. **If parents do NOT want their student(s) leaving campus during this time, please contact Mrs. DeGroot ([office@petraacademy.com](mailto:office@petraacademy.com)).** Students will need to check out at the Front Desk and then back in when they return. Students remaining on campus will be expected to eat lunch in the Cafeteria from 12:00-12:45 p.m. and then study from 12:45-1:30 p.m. in the Cafeteria.

**Students should not be at school unless they are studying for an exam, taking an exam, or participating in another faculty-supervised space or extracurricular activity.** This especially includes Friday afternoon, as teachers will be grading exams. We encourage parents and students to make other plans for Thursday afternoon to celebrate the end of exams.

**All students are expected to attend school Friday, June 2, for House activities and All-School Awards.** Friday dismissal will be at noon.
